We are a non-profit corporation dedicated to the elimination of hunger in south central Indiana. With the help of donors and volunteers, we rescue and store foods and provide them to over 90 member agencies. Our agencies serve people who are ill, needy, or minor children in Brown, Lawrence, Martin, Monroe, Owen, and Orange Counties.

### **HHFB member food pantries**

Our member food pantries serve anyone needing free groceries. Some pantries may require you to meet income guidelines to receive some items, but they can provide other items regardless of your circumstances. Food pantries vary in size and selection. ### **HHFB member on-site feeding programs**

Our member on-site feeding programs serve meals and snacks that you can eat there or take home. Some also offer shelter. This brochure shows agencies open to the public. HHFB's other on-site feeding partners include daycares, youth programs, and group homes.

### **Commodity Supplemental Food Program**

If you are over 60 years old and meet income guidelines, you may qualify to get a monthly box of food providing protein, calcium, iron, and vitamins. Contact Casey at HHFB, 812-334-8374.

*Every day in the United States, about one out of six people has to make difficult choices when it comes to basic necessities—food, shelter, healthcare, and childcare. Approximately 26,000 people in the Hoosier Hills Food Bank service area receive food assistance each month. South-central Indiana has dozens of free food pantries to serve people just like you. This brochure can help you find the one closest to you.*

### **Federal SNAP Benefits**

You and your family may be eligible to receive SNAP benefits (formerly known as food stamps) to help cover your monthly grocery costs. 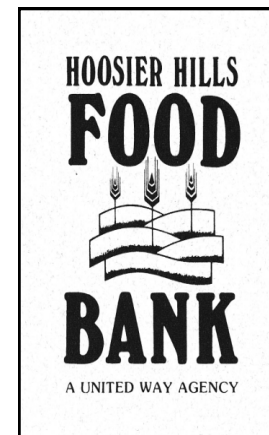
